### **Attendance**

The Education Act of 1996 states that it is the responsibility of parents or guardians to ensure that all children between the ages of 5 and 16 years attend school on a regular basis AND on time. Each week at Hartley, classes with attendance of 95% or above receive an attendance certificate; classes with the highest attendance also receive attendance stickers and a cup for their class.
