Closure of school due to frozen water pipes on Friday 2nd March

During severe weather conditions, we make every effort to keep the school open for as many children as possible. However, in some circumstances, following completion of a risk assessment, we may decide that it is necessary to temporarily close the school. In such circumstances we will always attempt to give parents and carers advance notice, but due to the unpredictable nature of some weather events this may not always be possible.

After the pupils had gone home on Thursday 1st March, following the completion of a risk assessment, we regrettably had to take the decision to close the school. This was due to frozen water pipes.

We communicated information about the closure from 4.30pm via our school website, Parentmail and Twitter.
