

Hartley Primary School Uniform

The school's uniform or 'dress code' is not compulsory but we would like all pupils to wear it. We hope that parents will find the clothes easy and inexpensive to obtain and will support our dress code.

We have not chosen a particular style for shoes but we do want children to wear shoes in which they are able to move around the school and the playground comfortably and safely. Children should not wear high heels or flimsy sandals to school.

Hartley sweat-shirts may be ordered and paid for at the school Medical Room or bought from Ian Howard's uniform shop at 409 Barking Road, E6 2JT.

For girls: skirts, trousers, tunics, shalwar-kamiz, jogging bottoms or dresses in navy blue, black or grey

For boys: trousers, or jogging bottoms in black or grey, rumals/turbans (if worn): white or navy blue

For boys and girls: white shirts, blouses or Hartley polo shirts

Coats any style, any colour but these must be marked with the child's name



Jewellery should not normally be worn and must certainly not be worn during PE. Children with pierced ears should wear small studs only, to avoid accidents. The school cannot accept responsibility for jewellery, watches, clothing or other valuable items which are worn or brought to school.
